City Council Meeting

The City Council of the City of Pilot Point, Texas met on this date at 6:00 p.m. for a Special City Council meeting.

A. ROLL CALL/CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Dane-Patterson announced a quorum at 6:00 pm and called the meeting to order.

B. Joint workshop with the Capital Projects Advisory Committee to discuss the possible November 2018 Bond Election and potential capital projects.

City Manager Guard stated that information cards are currently being passed out. There will be a presentation for each proposed item (5 stations) and each presentation will last five to six minutes. The town hall meeting will be at the intermediate school.

Poster boards will be used at each station. The following are the proposed projects:

- Streets (3 funding levels)
- Sidewalks
- Drainage Masterplan
- Public Buildings
- Downtown improvements

City Manager Guard stated that there will be videos prepared for show, there will be a FAQ sheet with information to show how the bond will affect property taxes.

Robert McMeen stated that everyone needs to be over prepared and be able to answer questions.

Howard Kimble stated he would like to see a report showing what everything totals.

Pastor Dwayne Edwards stated that the City Council needs details on everything to be able to answer questions. It is important that the City Council is present. It is the future of our City. In addition, he encouraged the City to send letters to senior citizens regarding the tax freeze program.

City Manager Alan Guard stated that after the town hall meeting, a committee will be put together to push the bond. Once the election is called, the City cannot spend any funds advocating the bond election.
