



REQUEST FOR COPY OF PEACE OFFICER'S CRASH REPORT

Texas Transportation Code, Sec. 550.065. Release of Certain Motor Vehicle Accident Report

Texas Transportation Code § 550.065 (c)(4) allows for the release of a crash report on written request and upon payment of required fee of any person directly concerned in the accident or having a proper interest therein. Please select one or more of the following:

- (A) Any person involved in the accident
 - (B) The authorized representative of any person involved in the accident
 - (C) A driver involved in the accident
 - (D) An employer, parent or legal guardian of a driver involved in the accident
 - (E) The owner of a vehicle or property damaged in the accident
 - (F) A person who has established financial responsibility for a vehicle involved in the accident in a manner described by T.C. § 601.501, including a policy holder of a motor vehicle liability insurance policy covering the vehicle
 - (G) An insurance company that issued an insurance policy covering a vehicle involved in the accident
 - (H) An insurance company that issued a policy covering any person involved in the accident
 - (I) A person under contract to provide claims or underwriting information to a person described by Paragraph (F), (G), or (H);
 - (J) A radio or television station that holds a license issued by the Federal Communications Commission
 - (K) A newspaper that is:
 - i: A free newspaper of general circulation or qualified under § 2051.044, Government Code, to publish legal notices;
 - ii: Publish at least once a week; and
 - iii: Available and of interest to the general public in connection with the dissemination of news
 - (L) Any person who may sue because of death resulting from the accident
- OR
- An agency of the United States, this state (Texas) or a local government of this state (Texas)
 - I do not meet any of the qualifications listed above, however, I certify that I am a person directly concerned in the accident or have a proper interest therein. Please provide an explanation for how you meet this requirement.
