
- A. Call to Order Meeting was called to order by Charlotte Bridges at 9:10 a.m.
- B. Consider approval of the KPPB Minutes.
 1. Minutes from the meeting held on June 11, 2019. Charlotte Petermeier made a motion to approve the June meeting minutes. Minutes were approved on a motion by Charlotte Petermeier and seconded by Alexis Martinez. Minutes were approved.
- C. Discuss, consider, and possible action on partnering with PPISD FFA students on an Operation Restoration Community Service Project. Mr. Blake Hesteande (Ag teacher, PPISD) presented his ideas for Operation Restoration (a community wide clean up service project). This project would involve the FFA students at Pilot Point ISD and would also include athletics students and students from other programs. His goal would be to help students learn more about investing in their community through serving and volunteer work. His goal would be to schedule one Saturday in May, 2020 to include 30 jobs. Charlotte Petermeier made a motion to approve KPPB partnering on this project, seconded by Charlotte Bridges. The Operation Restoration project was approved.

The Adopt A Street neighborhood program was approved.

Discuss, consider, and possible action on the proposed Wildflower Garden Project at the corner of Main St. and Washington St. **Stephanie Porter began discussion regarding the future Wildflower Garden project. Stephanie reported that Konrad Shields has given permission for KPPB to plant wildflower seeds on his property directly across the street from the bank building. This project would need to be implemented in October of this year, 2019 in order to have blooms for the spring of 2020. Stephanie agreed to take the lead on this project and keep in touch with KPPB committee regarding implementation steps. Charlotte Petermeier made motion to approve the project seconded by Charlotte Bridges. The Wildflower project was approved.**
